Classroom Lesson and Activity Summary

Sparkling & Shining Stars by Ms. Helga - June is National Rose Month and it's also the Zoo and Aquarium Month. We will have a fly a kite day on June 15th and Picnic Day on June 18th. We are going to start our water activities this month as well. The children will discover the many different kinds of animals that live in the deep blue sea, for example crabs, fish, squid, jellyfish, lobsters, sting rays, sea horses, sea shells, sea stars, octopus, and many more, and we will do various activities. We are going to create a big blue ocean in our classroom and place all the sea creatures in it. We will go over the letters "O" for ocean and "J" for Jelly Fish, all the basic colors and shapes, and the numbers 1 through 50. Our book for this month is Sea Creatures, and our songs are; "Happy Father's Day," "3 Little Fishes," "Small World," "Six Little Ducks."

Little Stars by Mrs. Madlin and Ms. Marie - The children will learn a little about each sea animal and do many fun arts and crafts. We will discuss the character of self discipline by using kind words and actions such as: be nice, be kind, be loving, sharing, say hi, good morning, thank you and much more. They will continue with their daily circle time that includes: alphabets; numbers 1 and 2; basic colors blue and green; and basic shapes square and rectangle. Our songs of the month are "Hickory, Dickory, Dock" and "Mary had a little lamb". Our books for the month are; Bear Loves Opposites! and This and That Bread.

Twinkling Stars by Mrs. Nona, Mrs. Romina, Mrs. Hermine and Mrs. Romina - In our Twinkling Stars room we, the teachers, stimulate and challenge our children by singing, talking, holding and playing with them. We do book reading and story telling by using our hands and facial expressions. We are going to introduce different fish to our Twinkling Stars by doing puppet shows and presenting pictures and books. We are going to make flags for our Flag Day by using red, white and blue crayons. Our book of the month is: Are You My Father by P.D. Eastman and our songs are: "I Love Daddy," "He is very Special," "Best Dad," and "Our Flag".
